

Harperman Farewell Sing-Along: Sunday, October 18 at 2:30 pm

(October 14, 2015) Tony Turner and other Canadian musicians will be singing Stephen Harper out of office on the steps of Parliament Hill at 2:30 pm on Sunday, October 18th - the eve of the federal election.

Billed as the ***Harperman Farewell Sing-Along***, the event will feature Turner, a Canadian singer/songwriter and retired federal government scientist, as he leads citizens on the Hill in singing his country-wide, viral YouTube hit, *Harperman*. Turner, who was prohibited by his employer from singing at the September 17th Parliament Hill performance of his iconic song, has added additional verses to his original lyrics, to reflect recent campaign developments.

Other Canadian musicians, including a busload of talent expected to travel with Turner to the Hill from the Folk Music Ontario Conference in Toronto, will be singing their songs of hope and change, and urging Canadians to vote.
